For example, if I do new java.security.SecureRandom(); and it will output random bytes. This seems to be a security issue, in that if I know the class loader, I can modify the implementation and not require the invoking code to be signed. I know about potential issues with the java security model being circumvented. However, this method just seems wrong to me. I think the java security model has been circumvented on purpose, in order to prevent bad code from running in the JVM. If I have a bytecode modification library which can override the secure random class loader in the JVM, what prevents me from modifying the java bytecode that happens to be compiled into a class that is loaded by the JVM, using some
